Agenda Items	TAG Discussion
1. Welcome and Introductions	The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m. by TAG Chair Alternate, Roger Heeringa. Roll call was taken, and Quorum was present.  Members of the public were given the opportunity to introduce themselves if they wished.
2. Review and Approve Agenda	Managing Director Dustin Curb presented the agenda.  Motion: Ricky Campbell moved to approve the agenda and Ken Brouillette second. The motion passed.
3. Review and Approve Minutes: April 16, 2024 April 23, 2024	Managing Director Dustin Curb presented April 16, 2024, and April 23, 2024 IFC TAG minutes.  Motion: Ken Brouillette moved to approve both minutes and Ricky Campbell second. The motion passed.
4. Emergency Rule Consideration: NAFED Licensing vs NICET Licensing	Motion: Ken Brouillette moved to accept NAFED Proponent Option 1 which would add a second exception to 2021 IFC 904.1.1. Jake Liddicoat second. TAG members and the public discussed level of experience required to perform inspections and recertification requirements. Motioned failed.

	<p>Motion: Ricky Campbell moved to accept Proponent Option 1 with modifications proposed by the Workgroup. The modifications changed the word “certification” to “Renewed Certificate.” Zachary Tuck second. TAG Members and the public held discussion on the level of experience offered by a renewed certificate and the impact of this change on currently available workforce. Motioned failed.</p> <p>Motion: Ken Brouillette moved to accept proponent option 2 which only extends the already existing delay for NICET licensing requirements from July 1, 2024, to January 1, 2025. Walker Donuji second. TAG Members and the public discussed working on the language as an Off Cycle Rule versus Emergency Rule. As an Off Cycle Rule, it will allow the TAG and the proponent create agreeable language to propose to the SBCC Council. Motion passed.</p>
<p>5. Review of work completed and received by staff</p>	<p>Dustin Curb presented the chapter assignment spreadsheet and confirmed chapter assignments with TAG members. Dustin also explained that documents received two days prior to subsequent TAG meetings will be included in the agenda for review, staff will work to prepare the documents to post and share for the meeting.</p> <p>Questions were addressed on how to vet the documents and significant changes.</p>
