b. Proposal addressing ESHB 1023Adult Family Home Capacity Increase to 8 Beds	The BFP Committee presented their recommended text. There were no public comments. The Council directed staff to file a CR-102 <i>Proposed Rule Making</i> for the IBC, the IEBC and the IRC to solicit public testimony
8. Energy Code Opinion request from Bellevue on Data Centers	Staff presented the request for an opinion (interpretation) brought before the Council and the proposed response. The opinion was approved as modified by the Council. There were no public comments.
9. FY 2021 Budget	Staff gave a brief summary of the 2021 Council Budget.
