STATE BUILDING CODE OPINION 21-Apr1

- **CODE:** 2018 IRC
- SECTION: IRC M1505.4 Dwelling Unit Ventilation
- **Background:** The ventilation requirements do not specifically address how to apply these requirements to unheated storage area conversions within an existing dwelling, attached garage conversions or additions to existing homes.
- **QUESTION 1:** Is it the intent of the code to require the ventilation for the entire existing home to comply with this section when an addition is constructed or a garage is converted?
- ANSWER: No, as long as the converted/added habitable space is provided with outside air and exhaust served from the existing dwelling.
- **QUESTION 2:** If the answer to question 1 is no; is it the intent to allow the attached garage conversions and additions to use the ventilation code in effect at the time the home was constructed?
- ANSWER: No. The code requires, in Section R102.7.1, that the addition/alteration conform to the requirements of the current code.
