Please oppose energy code proposals 21-GP-1-103, 21GP1-136 and 21-GP1-179 whereas these proposals will inhibit the ability in providing the consumers appropriate energy sources. And in many regional areas of Washington State, life-safety energy sources that will be required without reliance on an overloaded electric grid system in times of dire heating and cooling seasons.

We have always and recently had wind and ice storms in Eastern Washington and we lose power. I personally have had to use a portable generator to power my natural gas furnace and refrigerator for a couple weeks at a time due to no power. There is no way people can power enough electric heat off of a portable generator.

Please consider opposing 21-GP-1-103, 21GP1-136 and 21-GP1-179.
