To All Parties Interested in the Wildland Urban Interface (WUI) Technical Advisory Group

The State Building Code Council (SBCC) is seeking members for the Wildland Urban Interface (WUI) Technical Advisory Group (TAG). This TAG will address how the 2018 or 2021 WUI Code addresses construction and site conditions and will review code change proposals submitted to SBCC for consideration in the Administrative Code rulemaking process.

The WUI TAG will convene after the Group 2 code change proposal submittal period and will conclude with a report to the Building, Fire and Plumbing Codes Committee, which in turn will make a recommendation to the full Council. The WUI TAG will set a meeting schedule once convened. Means of participation will be virtual using Zoom and/or conference phone.

Applicants will be asked to confirm the support of a local or statewide organization, where possible. The deadline for applications will be April 8, 2022.
