IEBC Proposal 21-GP2-056	The proponent, Nathalie Boeholt, introduced the proposal. There were clarifying questions asked with responses from the proponent and discussion regarding the proposal. It was moved, seconded, and approved to forward the proposal, as written, to the BFP Committee for review.
IBC Proposal 21-GP2-095	The proponent, Webley Bowles, introduced the revised proposal. There was discussion held and comments of concern made. There were some clarifying questions asked with responses from the proponent. It was noted that perhaps the Building Code wasn't the right place for this proposal. Some editorial changes were made.
