| 21-GP2-021 608.5 | Steve Simpson provided a brief background of the proposal and spoke in support of the proposal. Steve Hart suggested a modification. Discussion ensued. Motion: Steve Simpson moved to approve proposal 21-GP2-021, as modified, it was seconded, and the motion passed. |
| | Discussion was held on the process for reviewing the proposals when submitted and if the intent of proposals 21-GP2-038, 039 and 040 were to amend the appendices. Stoyan Bumbalov, Managing Director, indicated the intent of these three proposals was to adopt the appendix from the model code, not to amend. Therefore, the entire appendix was not included in each of the proposals. Steve Hart said he spoke with the proponent, Ed Holmes, and the concept behind the verbiage for all three of his proposals was specific to the adoption of a jurisdiction. |
