Welcome and Introductions	Meeting called to order at 10 a.m. by Tony Doan, Council Vice Chair. Everyone was welcomed and roll was called. A quorum was present.
2. Review and Approve Agenda	The agenda was approved as written.
3. Review and Approve Minutes	The March 16, 2022, minutes were approved as written.
4. Cost Benefit Analysis     • WSEC-Commercial	Stoyan Bumbalov explained the code adoption process, including the development of the Cost Benefit Analysis, and noted the scope of work for the Ecotope report. It was also noted the final Draft CBA report from Ecotope will be presented to the Council, with public comments attached, at the April 22 Council meeting. Stoyan Bumbalov noted the Executive Summary contains the report's updates. With more questions to be asked about the report, a motion was made, seconded, and approved to take a 10-minute break and allow time for Henry Odum, from Ecotope, to join the meeting.  Henry Odum, Ecotope, provided a high-level review of some of the changes that were addressed from Council and the public comments they received. He highlighted several of the updates
