Agenda Items	Committee Actions/Discussion
1. Welcome and Introductions	The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Stoyan Bumbalov, SBCC Managing Director. Everyone was welcomed and roll was called. A quorum of the Committee was present. Chair was not present and Stoyan Volunteered Dave Kokot for Chair, he accepted.
2. Review and Approve Agenda	(10:06) Motion: Chris Seaman Moved to Approve the agenda. Quyen Thai Seconded. No Discussion was had. A Voice Vote was taken. The motion passed with no opposition.
3. Off Cycle Rule Discussion: Adoption of R-4 Occupancy Group	(10:09) Stoyan Bumbalov introduced the proposal to adopt the R-4 Occupancy Group. He explained that the draft shown was the result of work done within the IBC TAG. The language contained in the 2021 IFC is intended to reflect the language discussed within the 2021 IBC. (10:09) Ken Brouillette raised concern over R-4 Condition 1 / 2 and definition of “limited verbal or physical assistance” Discussion was had. Ken brought ICC proposal G5-21 into the discussion. This proposal modifies/adds definitions in the 2024 code.

	<p>(10:38) Motion: Quyen Thai made motion to include the most current version of definitions depicted in ICC proposal G5-21 as part of the language modifications included with this proposal. Ken Brouillette Seconded. A voice Vote was taken. The motion passed with no opposition.</p> <p>(10:40) Discussion continued for the remainder of the sections of the 2021 IFC affected by the proposal.</p> <p>(11:01) Motion: Paul Clark made a motion to send the proposal to the Building Fire and Plumbing Committee for review and comparison of changes made during this meeting vs the draft put forward by the Building Code TAG. Quyen Thai Seconded. Limited Discussion was had. A voice vote was taken and the motion passed with Ken Brouillette in opposition.</p>
