Agenda Items	TAG Actions
1. Welcome and Introductions	The meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m. Roll was called, and a quorum was present.
2. Review and Approve Agenda	Steve Simpson moved to approve the agenda, Brad McCutcheon seconded, the motion passed.
3. Review and Approve Minutes from June 6 and 18, 2024	David Price noted the June 6 meeting minutes needed correction on the last page, under Chapter 5, first paragraph, by changing "combination fitting" to "equipment manufacture."
	David Price moved to approve the minutes, as amended, Janise Goucher seconded, the motion passed.
4. Review Existing Amendments and Significant Changes Documents	IMC Significant Changes
	Chapter 11
	The TAG reviewed the changes and held some discussion. All of Staff's recommendations were accepted. In reviewing the changes to the refrigeration requirements, Ben Omura asked that the ICC summary of the A2L changes to the 2024 codes be included with the TAG report on significant changes.
	Chapter 12
	Discussion was held on the changes in Chapter 12 with all of Staff's recommendations accepted.

	Chapter 15
	Referenced standards were reviewed and accepted in accordance with Staff's recommendations.
	New Appendix D and E
	The TAG reviewed and agreed with Staff's recommendations.
	OTHER BUSINESS
	IBC TAG inquiry to the MVP TAG regarding correlating sections was discussed. In regard to IBC Section 1202.1, the MVP TAG is recommending to the IBC TAG that the existing state amendment be retained in its current form for no further amendments. Adding the dwelling unit language back in would add a level of confusion on the requirements for residential ventilation and could introduce conflict.
	Krista Braaksma reviewed the next steps in the process by indicating the reports generated from the TAG meetings will be presented to the MVPE Committee and then their recommendations and/or comments will be presented to the Council. Both of these meetings will be scheduled as "special" meetings later in July. She also mentioned the code change proposal process and provided information about the Group 2 codes.
