Plan for Review of Proposals received for 2024 International Building Code/International Existing Building Code	Managing Director, Dustin Curb, provided overview of projected timeline for reviewing the Code Change Proposals with the goal of completing the review for the Committee Meeting on November 8 <sup>th</sup> .

	There is a possibility that a Special Committee Meeting may be needed due to the volume of Code Change Proposals received.
	Dustin Curb went over the parameters that TAG Members are allowed to do when reviewing the Code Change Proposals as directed in SBCC 6291 bill. TAGs have the choice to recommend adoption of the proposal as is, modify language in the proposal or recommend not adopting the proposal. Any recommendations and/or proposal not unanimously accepted will need a rationale by the TAG. In addition, Dustin also explained that if the code change did not have a unanimous vote, staff will draft a "Minority Report" which will include the vote count. This will be a report presented to the BRFW Committee.
6. Discuss Proposal Development by TAG	Dustin Curb presented the IBC/IEBC schedule to review petitions received.
