	Discussion was held on SHB 1458 and the revision that were made. There was also discussion on emergency clauses and what could be handled with Emergency Rulemaking, if or when necessary.
	Roger Heeringa announced he had to leave the meeting at 2:34 and therefore there would no longer be a quorum.
	It was noted SB 5429 appeared to not be moving forward.
	It was noted that outreach had taken place to inform and ask questions

	to try and gain a better understanding of SB 5552. It was noted that SB 5249 (also pertaining to Kit homes) had no action for the SBCC.
	Jay Arnold indicated he provided information on SB 5747 at the hearing and no questions were asked of him and it appears this bill is not going to move forward. Angela Haupt indicated she submitted written testimony to remove section 4.
