Agenda Items	Council Actions/Discussion
Welcome and Introductions	Committee Chair, Tom Handy called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. Roll was taken and a quorum was established.  Dustin Curb let the Committee know the seats for both Daimon Doyle and Matthew Hepner are vacant as of April 5, with no reappointment or replacement.
2. Review and Approve Agenda	Todd Beyreuther moved to approve the agenda, Jay Arnold seconded, the motion passed.

4. Legislative Update	Dustin Curb noted there hasn't been any big movements on the bills associated with the SBCC. He did mention SB 5552 – Kit Homes has "pallet structures" stricken from the bill.
	Dustin Curb also noted 2SHB 1183 may have the elevator language added back into the bill. There was discussion about SBCC adopting Standards which should be L&I's process, what input has L&I given, what other regulations would be involved in the process, suggest L&I adopt and have correlation with SBCC, and it was suggested to reach out to the LNI Elevator Program to gather more information about the process prior to responding to the sponsor.
