Agenda Items	Council Actions/Discussion
1. Welcome and Introductions	Committee Chair, Tom Handy called the meeting to order at 2:05 p.m. Roll was taken and a quorum was not established.
2. Review and Approve Agenda	A quorum was not established; therefore, the agenda couldn't be approved.
4. Legislative Update	<p>Dustin Curb provided a brief background from Tuesday's meeting which involved drafting both written and oral testimony and to include some suggestions for language to be presented for both for SB 5055 – Agritourism, and SB 5552 – Kit Homes. He then noted oral testimony was given Wednesday and written testimony was submitted.</p> <p>Dustin Curb said both of the bills are scheduled for executive session, next week, but there not much for SBCC to do at this time, unless modifications are made, and further input is needed.</p> <p>Dustin Curb then reviewed the next two weeks schedule and noted Wednesday, April 2, is Opposite House Policy Cutoff and Tuesday, April 8, is the Opposite House Fiscal and Transportation Committee Cutoff. He provided a brief explanation for both of these processes and indicated more bills could be added to the schedule prior to these cutoff dates.</p>
