Code Section # C402.4 Fenestration

Brief Description Rev 2:

- Add exception for security glazing and revolving doors
- Clarify meaning of "operable."
- Add informative note to clarify fenestration categories.

Revision description: Delete revolving doors from proposed exception, since there are currently many double-pane products on the market.

Proposed code change text:

C402.4 Fenestration. Fenestration shall comply with Sections C402.4.1 through C402.4.5 and Table C402.4. Daylight responsive controls shall comply with this section and Section C405.2.4.

Exception: For prescriptive envelope compliance, single-pane glazing is permitted for security purposes and for revolving doors, not to exceed 1 percent of the gross exterior wall area. Where Section C402.1.5, component performance alternative, is used, the single glazing shall be included in the percentage of the total glazing area, U-factor and SHGC requirements.

Purpose of code change: Clarifies application of code to security glazing.

Clarifies application of code for small areas of single glazing for which code compliance is difficult.
