1. Welcome and Introductions	The meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m. by Council Chair Todd Beyreuther. Roll was taken and a quorum was present. Anyone from the public, who wished to, introduced themselves.

Todd Beyreuther provided an update on the research he did on the <b>IBC Code Change Petitions</b> , which was compared to the information that Dustin Curb had researched. Dustin Curb then provided additional information on the research he conducted. Notes were updated for the IBC Code Change Petitions in relation to the CBA and SBEIS.

Public concern was expressed with the limited timeframe and ability to receive well thought out responses.
