Agenda Items	TAG Discussion
1. Welcome and Introductions	The meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m. by Committee Chair Todd Beyreuther. Roll call was taken, and quorum was present. Members of the public were given the opportunity to introduce themselves.
2. Review and Approve Agenda	SBCC Staff presented the agenda. Motion: Dan Young moved to approve agenda. Angela Haupt second. Voice vote was taken, and motion passed.
3. Economic Impact Discussion and Planning	Chair, Todd Beyreuther, explained how this workgroup was created and Managing Director, Dustin Curb, explained the timeline for the 2024 Code Cycle, compliance with Administrative Procedures Act (RCW 34.05), Regulatory Fairness Act (RCW 19.85). Filing deadlines for the Cost Benefit Analysis, Small Business Economic Impact, and CR-102s is October 1, 2025, for all codes. Further discussion was held with members of the work group and members of the public. It was decided that each TAG Chair will conduct a review of Economic Impact of submitted proposals and bring their findings to the workgroup meetings. Group 1 IBC and IRC will be reviewed on August 18th.
