xxx.1 – Group R-2 SEMH. A manual fire alarm system that activates the occupant notification system in accordance with Section 907.5 shall be installed in Group R-2 SEMH occupancies. An automatic smoke detection system that activates the occupant notification system in accordance with 907.5 shall be provided in accordance with section xxx.1.2.

Exceptions:

- 1. Manual fire alarm boxes in R-2 SEMH are not required throughout the building where all of the following conditions are met:
 - a. The building is quipped throughout with an automatic sprinkler system installed in accordance with section 903.3.1.1.
 - b. The notification appliances will activate upon sprinkler water flow.
 - c. Not fewer than one manual fire alarm box is installed at an approved location.
- xxx.1.2 Automatic Smoke Detection. An automatic smoke detection system shall be installed throughout the following locations.
 - 1. Common spaces outside of dwelling units.
 - 2. Laundry rooms, mechanical equipment rooms and storage rooms outside of dwelling units.
 - 3. All interior corridors serving dwelling units.

xxx.1.3 Smoke Alarms. Single- and multiple station smoke alarms shall be installed in accordance with section 907.2.11.

Required smoke alarms in dwelling units in Group R-2 SEMH occupancies shall <u>may</u> be interconnected with the fire alarm system in accordance with A117.1 and NFPA 72.

Habitable spaces in dwelling units in Group R-2 SEMH occupancies shall be provided with visible alarm notification. Visible alarms shall be activated by the in-room smoke alarm and the building fire alarm system. (FPE question, is this interconnection possible without activating the entire building; is this interconnection needed?)
