1. Welcome and Introductions	The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m. by Committee Chair, Tom Handy. Roll was taken and a quorum was present. Anyone from the public, who wished to, introduced themselves.

Legislative Update	Dustin Curb shared the Week 5 SBCC Bill Tracking and the Week 5 Hearing Schedule documents and began review of the High Priority Bills by noting HB 2486 has been moved to this group. The Medium and Low Priority Bills were reviewed for their status, along with the Monitoring and Other Bills. Discussion was held on HB 2141, and it was noted written testimony was provided for the hearing that occurred February 4, 2026. Dustin Curb reviewed the relevant dates for the remainder of this Legislative Session as he shared the Legislative Session Cutoff Calendar. There was some discussion on the embodied carbon bills and Kjell Anderson indicated he submitted concerns on HB
