Agenda Items	Council Actions/Discussion
1. Welcome and Introductions	At 2:00 p.m. Dustin Curb noted Tom Handy, Committee Chair, wasn't present and asked for a volunteer to act as chair pro-tem. Jay Arnold volunteered with no objections heard. The meeting was called to order at 2:01 p.m. by Jay Arnold. Roll was taken and a quorum was present.
2. Review and Approve Agenda	<b>Motion:</b> Todd Beyreuther moved to approve the agenda, Ben Omura seconded, the motion passed.
3. Review and Approve Minutes: February 26	<b>Motion:</b> Todd Beyreuther moved to approve the minutes, Ben Omura seconded, the motion passed.
4. Legislative Update	Dustin Curb opened by listing the remainder of the Legislative Cutoff Dates and then shared the <a href="#">SBCC Week 9 Bill Tracking</a> and reviewed the status of the High, Medium, and Low Priority bills along with mentioning the Monitoring bills. Discussion was held on ESSB 5552, and it was noted this topic would be discussed at the Executive Committee meeting, Friday, March 6, with ideas and options being presented. Discussion was held on Fiscal Note information and was requested to find out the status to which Todd Beyreuther indicated he was in Olympia, this week, and would check in, mention the fiscal note, and see what he could find out.

5. Other Business	A request was made for an update and discussion on the outcome of the SEMH TAG meeting that was held on Tuesday, March 3. Roger Heeringa, SEMH TAG Chair, provided a recap of the meeting and noted there were concerns with the proposed modifications and a majority were in support of the original document. Further discussion was held on Legislative intent and the need for clarity when bills are written.
